2020 Presidential election

What Pape was seeing in these results did not fit the government model of lone wolfs and small groups of extremists. "This really is a new, politically violent mass movement," he told me. "This is collective political violence."

Pape drew an analogy to Northern Ireland in the late 1960s, at the dawn of the Troubles.
