It's also true, of course, that younger politicians can suffer debilitating illnesses.

True, too, that older people with access to good health care can now lead productive public lives well past the ages at which their political forebears would have died or become incapable.

But in other democracies where healthy life spans are just as long as those in the US,

the governing class is nonetheless much younger.
