

By the numbers

An August analysis by the Cato Institute, a libertarian think tank, using data from multiple sources reached a similar conclusion [to the Center for the Study of Hate and Extremism], finding that since 1992, 219 people have been killed in attacks by "nationalist and right wing terrorists"; 23 were killed by "left wing terrorists," including 13 since the start of 2016.
