By the numbers

Globally, the McKinsey researchers calculated that 49 percent of time spent on work activities could be automated with "currently demonnstrated technology" either already in the marketplace or being developed in labs.

That, the report says, translates into \$15.8 trillion in wages and the equivalent of

1.1 billion workers worldwide. But only 5 percent of jobs can be entirely automated.
