The world has more than 70 times as many stock market indices as it has quoted stocks, according to a survey by the Index Industry Association.

A census of its members found that they publish and regularly recalculate 5.28m indices, of which 3.14m cover stock markets. According to the World Bank, the number of public companies in existence is only 43,192.
