All of the 10 highest-paid executives [in 2021] had compensation over \$100 million, a first.

Their average compensation was \$330 million, the highest ever.

But it's not just a few executives at the top enjoying the spoils.

Underscoring how widespread the pay increases were last year, the median chief executive made \$32.1 million in 2021, up 27 percent from \$25.3 million in 2020 and far higher than in prepandemic years.
