Income inequality

In 2018,

the median household income for a black family was \$41,361, having grown 3.4 per cent over the previous decade, according to the latest US Census Bureau data. This compared with a median income \$70,642 for non-Hispanic whites which had grown 8.8 per cent since the 2008 crisis.
