Income inequality

A July report from the **Economic Policy Institute found** that the chief executive officers of America's largest companies made an average of \$15.6 million in compensation in 2016, or 271 times the annual average pay of ordinary workers. Although that gap has narrowed over the past few years, it's still astronomically larger than the 20 times recorded in 1965.
