

Income inequality

The largest gap between chief executive and workers in the survey was at Amazon, where this spring a union won a battle to organize a warehouse for the first time.

Andrew Jassy, who took over from Jeff Bezos as Amazon's chief executive last year, had pay that was 6,474 times that of the company's median employee. His compensation last year, \$213 million, was the eighth highest, according to Equilar [a compensation consulting firm].
