Inequality

[T]hose who find themselves in the worst positions have the most pressures to find legitimacy in the social order. The alternative -believing that the system is unjust, unfair, or even randomis in fact painful and generates more stress. Approving of the system therefore serves a "palliative function," even though in practice it discourages seeking beneficial changes that might concretely redress exising inequalities.
