Journalism

Studiously mindful of traditional norms of objectivity and balance, they retreat from interpretation back to what seems more uncontentious information: the old "you write what the man says." But symmetrical coverage in situations of asymmetrical polarization where only one party has turned against fundamental democratic rules or is misleading the public systematically about basic facts turns into distortion. The effects of a self-consciously

neutral stance are not neutral.
