Xi Jinping has been practising it on an awesome scale for a decade. The oldest democracies have been able to nurse the hope that, if you are a populist, you must also be too venal and inept to last in office and so the system is self-righting. Liberals elsewhere have learnt the hard way that this is too neat, too Whiggish.
