

# Post-2014 Senate situation

## 13 states

(Alaska, Alabama, Arkansas, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Mississippi, Nebraska, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Wyoming)

**2014 population: 35,432,696**

**Senators: 26 Republicans**

**1 Senator per 1,362,796 people**

## 1 state (California)

**2014 population: 38,332,521**

**Senators: 2 Democrats**

**1 Senator per 19,166,261 people**

**19,166,261 / 1,362,796 = 14, therefore:  
average 13er's vote is worth 14 times a Californian's,  
a Californian's vote is worth 7% of an average 13er's**

## 1 state (Wyoming)

**2014 population = 582,658, therefore:**

**1 Senator per 291,329 Wyomians,**

**a Wyomian's vote is worth 66 times a Californian's,  
a Californian's vote is worth 1.5% of a Wyomian's**
