

Post-2018 Senate situation

15 states

(Alaska, Arkansas, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming)

2018 population: 40,056,961

Senators: 30 Republicans

1 Senator per 1,335,232 people

—

1 state (California)

2018 population: 39,776,830

Senators: 2 Democrats

1 Senator per 19,888,415 people

19,888,415 / 1,335,232 = 16, therefore:

**average 15er's vote is worth 16 times a Californian's,
a Californian's vote is worth 6% of an average 15er's**

—

1 state (Wyoming)

2018 population = 573,720, therefore:

1 Senator per 286,860 Wyomians,

**a Wyomian's vote is worth 69 times a Californian's,
a Californian's vote is worth 1.4% of a Wyomian's**
