**19,684,037 / 1,336,180 = 14.7, therefore:
average 15er's vote is worth nearly 15 times a Californian's,
a Californian's vote is worth less than 7% of an average 15er's**

1 state (Wyoming)

2020 population = 582,328, therefore:

1 Senator per 291,164 Wyomians,

**a Wyomian's vote is worth 68 times a Californian's,
a Californian's vote is worth 1.5% of a Wyomian's**
