I would suggest a more realistic view: for much of its history the Supreme Court has been the most conservative branch of the US government, and its justices have been chiefly motivated by their personal ideologies, which, like all good lawyers, they camouflage as solid reasoning.

I think a more objective view is to recognize that the justices sought to impose their conservative views on the will of the majority by concocting legal theories to fit the moment.
