Honda commenced deliveries of its radical RC213V-S, a road-legal version of its World Championship-winning Moto GP race bike – which come with a suitably exotic price tag of £150,000. The 1,000cc V-4 engine produces 157hp (or more than 212 with the “race kit” fitted) and sits in a frame made from raw aluminum, meaning the machine must be housed in a heated garage to prevent it from corroding.
