According to Pew [Research Center], the gap in wealth between upper-income households and lower- and middle-income households in 2016 was the highest since the Federal Reserve began collecting such data in 1983. There are also signs of greater strain on lower-income white households, many of which voted for Mr Trump last year, with 17 per cent of them having a net worth of zero or below.
