The median U.S. household net worth
is \$118,200.

Bezos has \$172,000,000,000.

So ... how does that compare?

whose answers are physical comparisons — e.g.,
if household worth = size of a white blood cell,
then Bezos' worth = size of a finback whale

[An arithmetic comparison is that
Bezos' net worth of \$172,000,000,000
= net worth of 1,455,161 median households,
which contained 2.64 people in 2022,
which means his net worth in 2022
= that of at least 3,841,625 people,
which is more people than live in 24 states or
in any city other than New York and Los Angeles]
