Average wealth of a 1426er:
 $\$5,400,000,000.000 / 1,426 = \$3,786,816,269$

Average wealth of a 250,000,000er:
 $\$5,400,000,000.000 / 250,000,000 = \$21,600$

$\$3,786,816,269 / \$21,600 = 175,315$
Average wealth of a 1426er = combined assets
of 175,315 250,000,000ers
